MEWP Operator Training & Certification Scissor Lift (aka Flying Carpet) & Boom (aka Cherry Picker) Joint Machine Course



This course is designed to provide compliance with the HASAWA regulations, The Working at Heights Regulations, the Provision and Use of Work Equipment Regulations (PUWER) and the Lifting Operations and Lifting Equipment Regulations (LOLER) instructing delegates in all aspects of the safe and correct use of this equipment. This will cover both the Scissor Lift and Articulated Boom machines The course will include use of harnesses as per host companies systems and policy.

Course Overview

The course will cover the subjects below relevant to both MEWP types.

- Legal Duties
- Regulations and Legal Obligations
- Functions of components
- Safety inspection
- Safe Operating Practices
- Safety Features & Mechanisms
- Correct PPE selection & use
- Battery Charging / Refueling
- Control Function Checks
- Emergency Procedures
- Specific working environment practices.

Delegates will undertake following examinations on both the Scissor & Boom Machines

- Joint Machines Safety Knowledge examination
- Separate Machine Pre Use Safety examinations
- Separate Machine Practical Examinations Of Operating Skill.

As the course covers both machine types, numbers are limited to a maximum of 4 per course. Successful Delegates will be issued with Full Certification and ID pocket cards. HSCS will take need to take the delegates photographs for certification. If this is a problem due to security etc, please supply electronic 'passport' style photographs.

The course fees are fully inclusive of all training materials, training manuals, examination fees, registration fees, delegate reports, course reports and certification and includes all travel and expenses to any mainland site.

For training at your site we will require access to suitable and safe equipment (PUWER/LOLER), practical operating area, a room suitable for the number of delegates with a 230v 13amp 3 pin power supply and suitable PPE for delegates.
